Motion to amend the Constitution of the the Canadian Linguistic Association

Whereas the members of the Executive Council of the CLA wish to formalize the role of Webmaster;

Be it resolved that the following changes to the Constitution of the the CLA be adopted:

1. NAME – The name of the Association shall be the Canadian Linguistic Association Inc.
2. OBJECT – The object of the Association shall be to promote the study of languages and linguistics in Canada.
3. OFFICIAL LANGUAGES – The official languages of the Association shall be English and French.
4. MEMBERSHIP – There shall be four classes of members: regular members, honorary members, student members and institutional members.
 - a. Membership of the Association shall be open to any person on payment of dues.
 - b. The Executive Council may grant the title of honorary member to persons who have rendered outstanding service to the Association.
 - c. Only members in good standing may submit papers to the annual conference of the Association.
5. OFFICERS – The officers of the Association shall be the President, the Vice-President, the Treasurer, the Secretary and the Editor of the journal of the Association.
6. DUTIES AND POWERS OF OFFICERS – The officers are empowered to represent the Association in its external relations.
7. COMPOSITION OF THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL – The Executive Council shall consist of the President, the Vice-President, the immediate past President, the Treasurer, the Secretary, the Editor and Co-Editor of the journal of the Association, the Chairperson of the Program Committee, the Webmaster, two Members-at-large, and a student member.
8. TERMS OF OFFICE OF MEMBERS OF THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL
 - a. The term of office of the President shall be two years. The Vice-President shall be elected for a term of two years and shall succeed to the presidency at the expiration of the President’s term of office. The terms of office of the President and the Vice-President shall not be renewed.
 - b. The Treasurer, ~~and~~ the Secretary, and the Webmaster shall be elected to serve for five years, and may serve more than one consecutive term in their respective positions. The term of office of the Editor of the journal of the Association shall be three years. The Co-Editor shall be elected for a term of three years and shall succeed to the editorship at the expiration of the Editor’s

term of office. Whenever possible, the Co-Editor will represent the official language other than that of the Editor. The terms of office of the Editor and the Co-Editor shall not be renewed.

- c. The two Members-at-large shall be elected to serve for two years and shall not serve more than once in succession. The terms of office of these members shall overlap so that both are not elected in the same year.
- d. The Chairperson of the Program Committee shall be elected to serve for three years, and may serve a second consecutive term.
- e. The student member shall be appointed by the Executive Council to serve for a term of one year, and shall not be eligible to serve a second term.

9. DUTIES AND POWERS OF THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL – The Executive Council is charged with conducting the affairs of the Association. Its duties and powers shall be the following:

- a. The Council shall set and levy such dues as it deems necessary to finance the Association.
- b. The Council shall make such expenditures as it deems necessary to operate the Association.
- c. The Council shall establish such ad hoc committees as it deems necessary for the furtherance of the aims of the Association.
- d. The Council shall be responsible for the agenda of the Annual General Meeting of the Association.
- e. The Council shall appoint the local arrangements coordinator for the Annual General Meeting and delegates to other organizations.
- f. The Council shall take any other action it deems necessary for the maintenance, financing and operation of the Association.

10. THE TREASURER shall collect and disburse funds and maintain the financial records of the Association. The Treasurer may establish and name a committee to assist in these tasks.

THE SECRETARY shall maintain the membership rolls, conduct elections and voting, and maintain the archives of the Association. The Secretary may establish and name a committee to assist in these tasks.

11. THE EDITOR OF THE JOURNAL shall be responsible for the contents of the journal of the Association. The Editor shall name a Book Review Editor, a Squibs Editor, and an Editorial board to assist in the conduct of journal affairs.

12. STANDING COMMITTEES – There shall be two standing committees of the Association: the Nominating Committee and the Program Committee.
- a. The Nominating Committee shall consist of the immediate past President as Chair, and two persons elected from the membership of the Association.
 - b. The Program Committee shall consist of four voting members and a non-voting chair. These five people shall be elected from the membership of the Association.
13. TERMS OF OFFICE FOR STANDING COMMITTEES
- a. The members of the Nominating Committee shall be elected for two-year terms and shall not serve more than once in succession. The terms of these members shall overlap so that both are not elected in the same year.
 - b. The members of the Program Committee shall be elected for four-year terms. One voting member shall be elected each year. Members of the Program Committee shall not serve more than once in succession.
14. DUTIES OF STANDING COMMITTEES
- a. The Nominating Committee shall nominate one person for each elective position within the Association.
 - b. The Program Committee shall decide which scholarly papers are to be accepted for presentation at the Annual General Meeting of the Association.
15. ELECTIONS – The Nominating Committee shall propose to the Annual General Meeting a nominee for each of the vacant elective positions of the Association. Members in good standing may also make nominations either (i) from the floor or (ii) by means of mail ballot or a telephonic, electronic or other communication facility, providing that such communication facility permits anonymous and verifiable voting.
- a. A nomination made by the method described in 15(ii) must be received by the Secretary one month before the Annual General Meeting, and must include the signature of the nominee, as well as that of two members in good standing. The Secretary shall immediately inform the Nominating Committee of this new nomination.
 - b. A nomination from the floor of the Annual General Meeting shall be proposed by a standard motion; the nominee must have agreed to the nomination. The Annual General Meeting shall approve the nominations proposed by the Nominating Committee when there is only one nominee for each position. These candidates shall take up their duties immediately. If there is more than

one nominee for a position, an election by the method described in 15(ii) shall be conducted.

16. MEETINGS – There shall be an Annual Conference of the Association and an Annual General Meeting. A quorum at the Annual General Meeting shall consist of those present at the meeting. There shall also be at least one meeting per year of the Executive Council.
17. AMENDMENTS to this Constitution may be proposed by the Executive Council or by ten members of the Association in good standing. In either case, proposed amendments, with the explanatory “whereas” clauses, must be submitted in writing to the Secretary and shall be voted on by the method described in 15(ii) and conducted among members in good standing by the Secretary. Motions for amendments must be sent to the membership by the Secretary no later than one month after the date of receipt by the Secretary. Votes must be cast within one month from the send-date of the ballots. To be adopted, an amendment must be approved by at least two-thirds of the votes cast. An adopted amendment shall take effect immediately.

Highlights of this past year

- We funded the virtual CLA 2020
- We funded prizes for CLA award recipients
- Support for linguists throughout Canada
 - Four applications from April 2020 and October 2020 received partial support
 - We received two applications in April 2021, which are have also received support

Transactions

- CLA has a checking and a savings account with National Bank
 - We will report the transactions for each bank account
 - In December 2019, we made an \$80,000 investment in GICs – Diversified Flex GICs; principal 100% protected at maturity; interest at maturity: guaranteed/max. 2.81% / 29.06%.
 - When these funds mature in December 2024, we hope to have increased our savings significantly.
 - Opening Investment: \$80,000; Market value on March 31, 2021: \$82,551.74
 - Rate of return since opening: 2.26%
 - Rate of return in past 12 months: 6.53%
 - Interest rate had we kept funds in savings account: 1.35%
 - Very volatile market due to COVID but things will hopefully settle down before maturity in November 2024
 - Even under the circumstances, we have done 80-85% better than before.

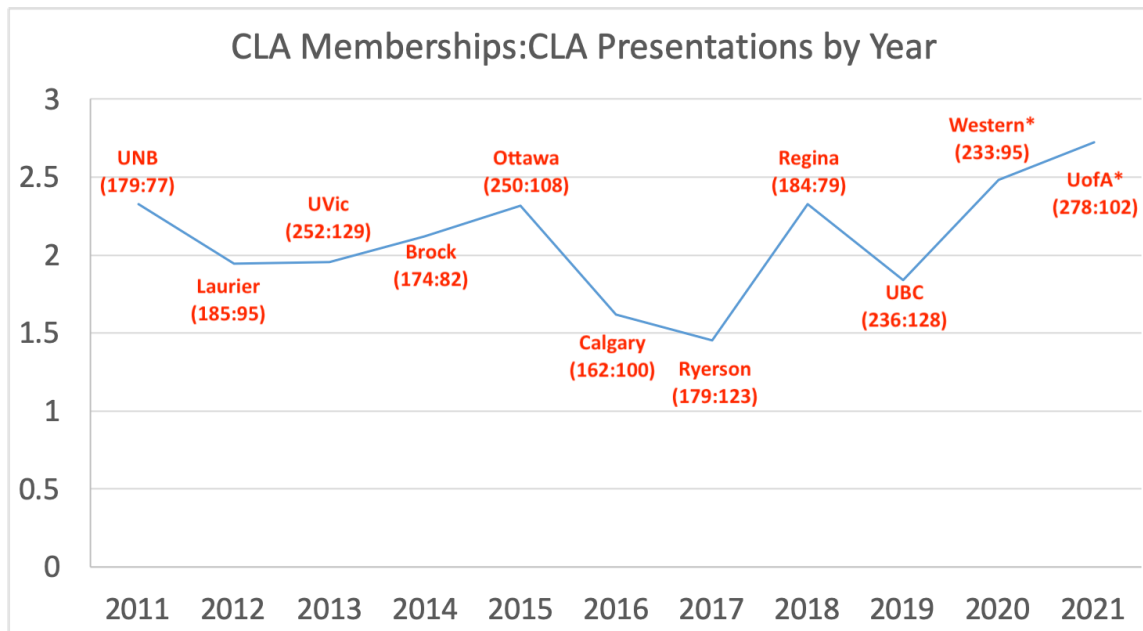

3. Graphs, tables, and other graphical representations of data

The inclusion of graphical representation of data (graphs, charts, etc.), as well as Tables and Tableaux will follow the formatting guidelines as outlined below.

3.1 Numbering and naming

Tables should be numbered separately from other examples and figures (Table 1, Table 2, etc.) Numbering should be placed above each table and should be followed by a descriptive title of the table. An example is given below (Table 1).

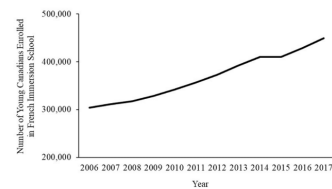


Figure 1. Change in the number of young Canadians enrolled in French immersion school outside of Quebec between the years 2006 and 2017. (Statistics Canada, 2017)

Figures (including charts, graphs, pictures, trees) should be numbered separately from other examples and tables: Figure 1, Figure 2, etc. Include a descriptive title below each figure following numbering (using the font Times New Roman 12). An example is given below (Figure 1).

3.2 Other considerations

Tables should use horizontal lines, and whenever possible avoid the use of vertical lines. Figures included should be in as high resolution as possible. Figures and tables should be centred horizontally in the page.

Consider if colour in your figures and tables is necessary, otherwise restrict yourself to black and white. Colour use should be used conservatively and purposefully. Avoid colours that are difficult to see such as yellow and neon colours.
